Procedure for dealing with Dangerous Animal and Pets

1. Upon discovering a dangerous animal on site the Coordinator or Property Manager will be contacted immediately. The Coordinator or Property Manager will contain and remove the animal if possible. The Christchurch City Council Animal Control Unit will be contacted as appropriate to the situation.
2. Children will be kept indoors until the animal is removed.
3. If a pet is brought onto the premises or lives on the premises it will be appropriately restrained at all times. If possible the owner will be encouraged to keep the animal out of the children's designated areas. The owner will be responsible at all times for the wellbeing of their animal. This includes feeding, watering and cleaning of faeces.
